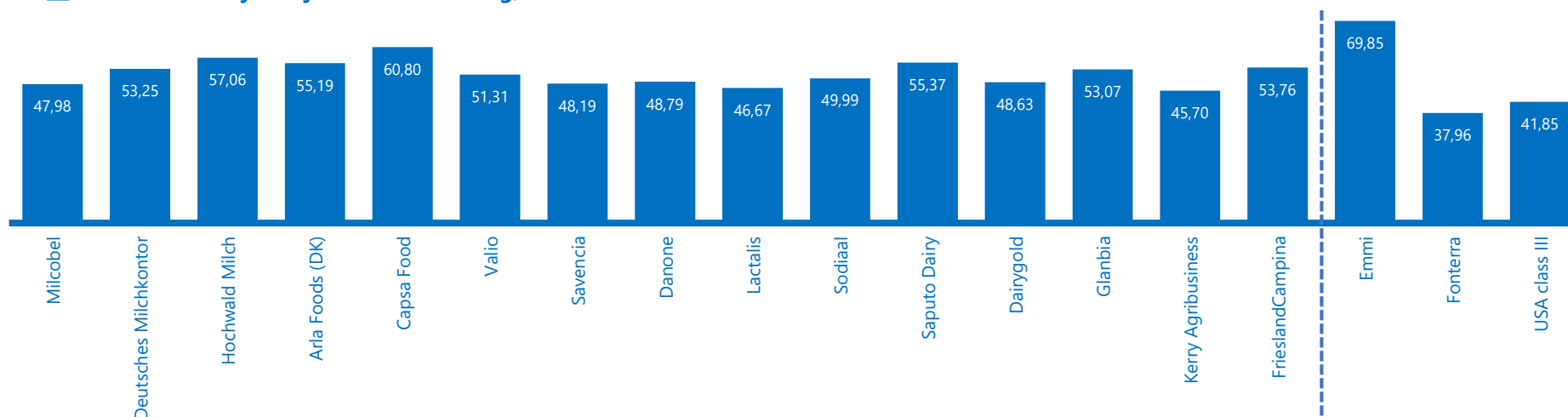

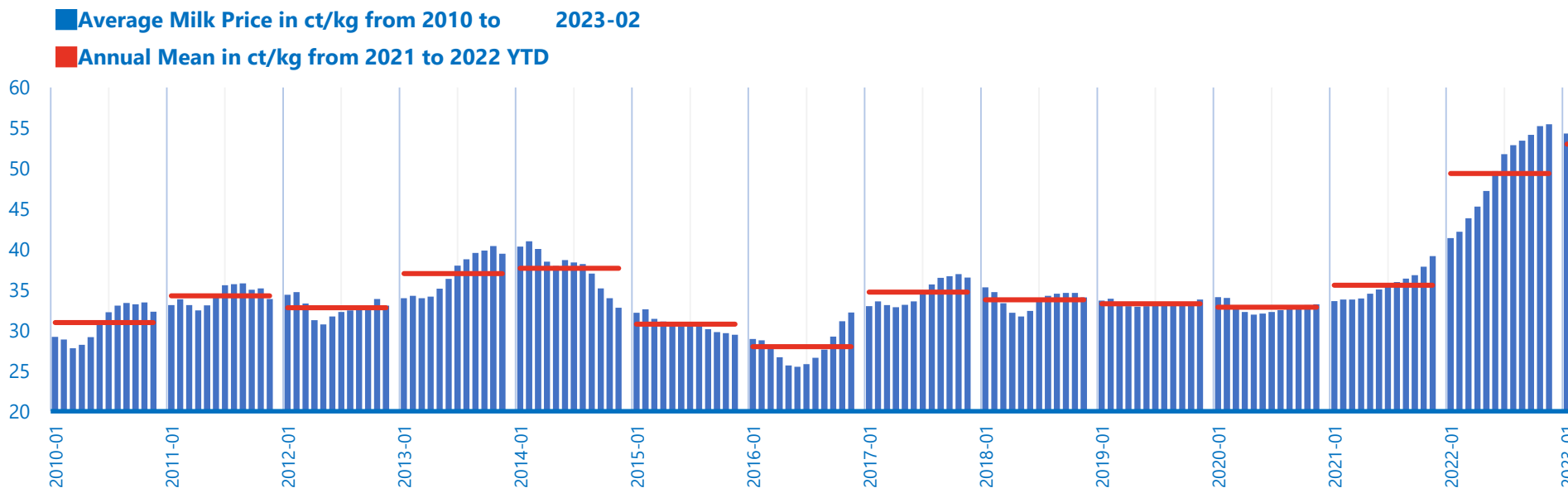
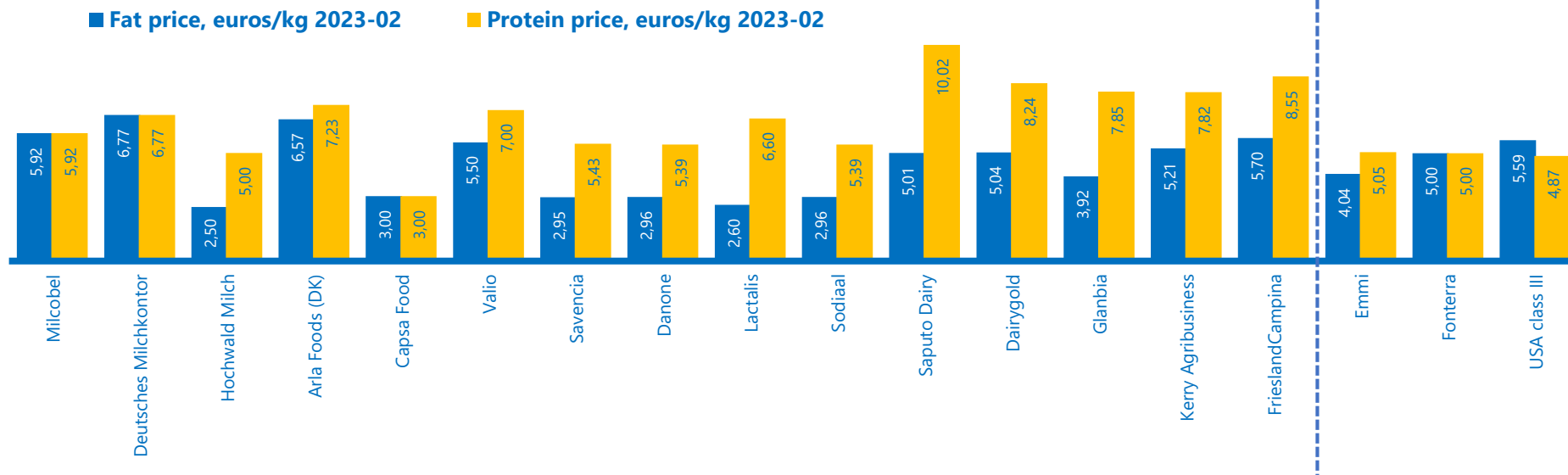
■ Milk Prices by Dairy Processor in ct/kg, 2023-02
